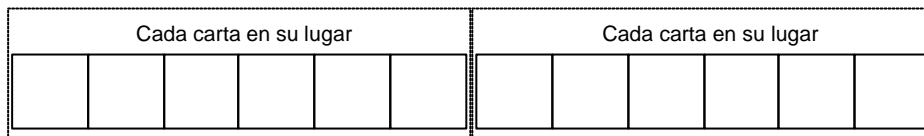


EACH CARD IN ITS PLACE-3

In this third version of the game the rules are the same, but the kids will use the sets of cards of the two previous games all together. Each team will have, thus, 12 cards, that will represent 12 consecutive numbers, from 2 to 13. They will need two boards, as it is seen in this figure.
