

CHANGE THE POSITION-1

It is a game in which, initially, we have certain number of counters, small cubes or any other object of a certain color and the same number of another, placed in a board as it is indicated below.

1. Board and initial position with a red and a blue counter:



2. Board and initial position with 2 red and 2 blue counters:



3. Board and initial position with 3 red and 3 blue counters:



The game consists of interchanging the position of the red and the blue counters.

Final position



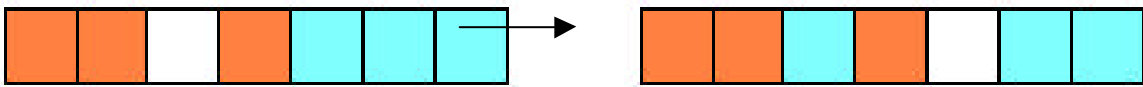
To do so, only these movements are allowed:

1. A counter can be moved a place to its left or its right, if there is an empty space.

2. A counter can jump on another one, of different color, if when doing so it is going to be placed in an empty space.

✂✂ To start with, you are going to play with a red counter and another one blue, in the board of three squares. **Place the counters** in the initial position. You already know what you must get and the movements that you can do, so, **let's play!** (As you are in pairs, one first and then the other).

YOU WILL NEED:
Two small cubes of each color and the sheet with the game 1
(3 squares).
